

Jovenes housed **183 UNDUPLICATED YOUTH** throughout all of our programs in 2017 and we are constantly engaging with youth on our waiting list as we seek to secure housing options for them. Below is a brief snapshot of who we served, their background and our programs' overall success in helping our youth achieve housing stability.

## PROGRAM SUCCESS

**54%** of youth served in Transitional Housing increased their housing stability (20 youth served)

**82%** of youth served in the Emergency Shelter increased their housing stability (104 youth served)

**96%** of youth served in Permanent Housing increased or maintained their housing stability (84 youth served)

## YOUTH WITH SYSTEMS EXPERIENCE

**21%** of youth served have experience only in the foster care system

**16%** of youth served have experience only in the probation system

**20%** are Crossover Youth meaning they have experience in both the foster care and probation system

**57%** of total youth served have systems experience

\*This demographic represents Jovenes' permanent housing programs only. In FY2017, Jovenes was unable to serve females in our short-term housing and 100% of clients served in our Emergency and Transitional Housing program were male. In 2018, we expanded our short-term housing programs to include the first scattered-site transitional housing program dedicated to transition-aged females in Southeast LA.
